- Passion: you like to engage on the topics not only during your studies, but also outside the classroom.
- Proactivity: you read, research, travel or are curious about the topics and you want to do something about it!
- Creativity: you are eager to experiment with new things, ideas and experiences!
- University student from an EucA member or an EucA alumni (priority will be given to current EucA students).
- 1'5 h availability per week.
